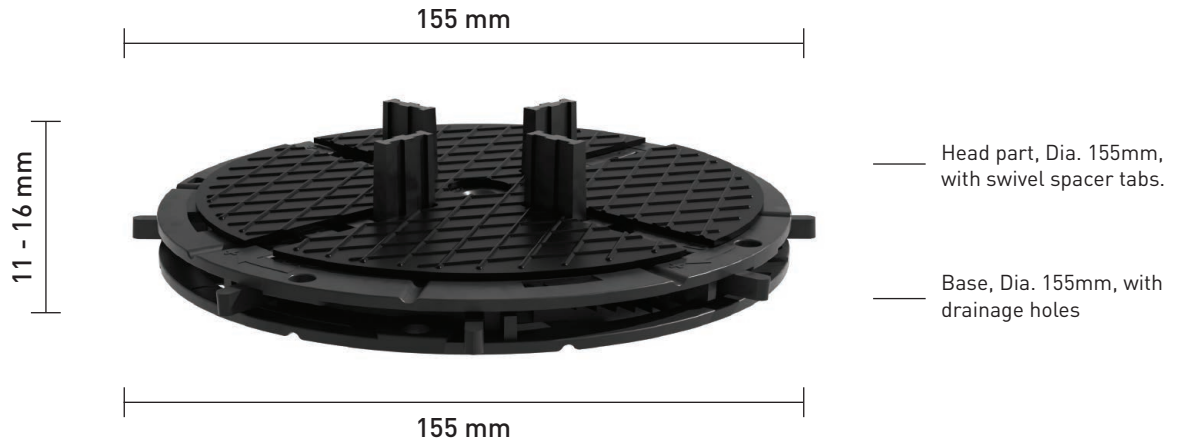

Adjustable paver pedestal



ADJUSTABLE HEIGHT

Adjustable height from 11mm to 16mm uninterrupted

COMPOSITION

1 head + 1 base + 1 spacer tab + 1 shim

MATERIAL

Polypropylene (PP), material thickness 4.5 - 6mm;
Composition 90% PP, 10% talc, UV and black masterbatch
100% recyclable.

DIMENSIONS

Head = diameter 155mm - surface area 188cm²
Base = diameter 155mm - ground surface 188cm²
Extender = extender diameter 120mm - adjustable height

PERFORMANCE

Resisting UV rays, weather, sea salt & almost all chemicals.
Temperature range: -40°C to +120°C.

APPLICATION

Support for outdoor terraces with any kind of material:
timber decking, stone, ceramic, composite material, metal,
fibreglass grid... Can be placed on any stable substrate,
also over insulation panels.

SLOPE CORRECTOR FROM 0% - 5%

Slope correctors could compensate ground fall 0% - 5%,
making an ideal level surface. It is assembled on the
bottom of pedestals. Clients could choose to use it or not
with different installation conditions.

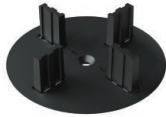

APPLICATION DETAILS



1. Spacer tab thickness: 2mm, 3.5mm, 5mm, 8mm, 10mm



2. Slope corrector: slope compensation of 0% - 5%



1 mm / 2 mm thickness

3. Shim: anti-slip, reduced impact, absorb shock and sound, compensate for a difference in floor thickness



Made in PP

4. Fix Collar: Fix and lock height after adjustment, increases stability.



COMPRESSION TEST

Performed on the full (1/1), half (1/2) or quarter (1/4) surface of the head

Position	Height (mm)	Breaking Loads (kgs)
1/1	17	1350
1/2	17	1162
1/4	17	982

Safety Value for maximum allowable load by compression for PBP-A:

1. Safety for pedestrian terrace: divide the load indicated in the table by 2 with a safety factor of -15%.
2. Safety for technical floors: divide the load indicated in the table by 4 with a safety factor of -15%.
